The True Stars Among Us**

Rabbi Pasaych Krohn is a world-renowned author and speaker, as well as a fifth generation mohel. He has written books on *brit milah* and on *chesed*, and his ten volume *Maggid* series was inspired by his family's close relationship with Rabbi Sholom Schwadron, the Maggid of Jerusalem. Rabbi Krohn also leads Jewish historical tours throughout Europe and has produced interactive CDRom and DVD sets on The Yeshivas of Yesteryear.



His fascinating videos give us a peek into many Eastern European communities including Italy, Greece, Frankfurt, Prague, Vienna, Morocco, Spain, and Gibraltar.

Rabbi Krohn is also an involved Jewish Community leader. He was instrumental in the founding of Shevach High School in Queens and American Friends of Migdal Ohr, and American Friends of Kiryat Chinuch Labonim, schools for Sephardic and Russian children in Ashdod.

Although Rabbi Krohn comes to us from New York, he actually has roots here in our region. His grandfather, Rabbi Hanoch Krohn, was a rabbi in McKeesport, and his uncle, Rabbi Benjamin Krohn, was a rabbi in Donora.

We are greatly looking forward to hearing the words of wisdom which Rabbi Krohn will impart to us tonight.

Greetings

from the Rabbi

Dear Kehillah,

As we begin the month of Adar, we find ourselves approaching a Purim where our usual simcha is challenged by the realities of the Covid world that we continue to occupy. I am reminded of a story I shared a number of times over the last year from my revered Rosh Yeshiva, Rav Yehdua Amital zt'l:

"When I was in a forced labor camp during the Holocaust, I used to put my cleanest shirt (although it also was far from clean) in my pocket on Friday morning. I would then put it on an hour or so before Shabbat. Although it was a far cry from my normal Shabbat dress, it was very meaningful for me to put on that shirt, even more meaningful than dressing for Shabbat usually is. Since all of my emotions were focused on this one action (because this was all I could do), it was very meaningful. Since I was forced to work on Shabbat, this constituted the extent of my preparing for and honoring Shabbat."

Again and again, I have found the model of Rav Amital's shirt so meaningful in facing the challenges of covid: that in the moments when we are constrained from expressing our Avodas Hashem in the conventional ways, that we need to focus all of that experience through the more limited vessels available to us.

Reflecting on the past 12 months--- a Seder table with just my immediate family, sharing classes online, working on planning safe options for our community to mark Yom Tov, singing and dancing in place outdoors on Simchas Torah---- I am so grateful for the lens of "Rav Amital's shirt" providing outlet and connections, both in our connection to Hashem and how we have been able to continue our connections to each other. Over the past year, I have been so inspired by the efforts of so many in our community who helped us find those "shirts": from acts of chesed, to creative programming for children, to the dedication of so many to keep up our minyanim.

As we once again enter the season of Purim and Pesach, I am filled with hope that we are approaching a time where we will be blessed to return fully to our communal life--- and that in the meantime, we continue to find vehicles for simcha.

The gematria, numerical value, of the word גבור is 211. Of note, this same value is shared also by the words ירא (yarei), חברא (chaburah) and ארי (ari). Chaburah means fellow or companion and this evokes the fellowship that we have together with our fellow congregants. Finally, ari is lion and this is used to represent scholar or learned one.

Congregation Poale Zedeck represents scholarship and learning, fellowship with each other and ultimately Yiras Shamayim. A Message from our Youth Director

This year has been a challenging one for all. Despite this, PZ Youth has been working hard on ensuring that we provide some "pandemic appropriate" programming that keep our youth connected to our Shul. Programming included (but is not necessarily limited to): A Shavuot Zoom "cheesecake baking," and a chesed opportunity to make craft flowers for the elderly in our community; Tisha B'av take home "craft kits," to provide the children with educational activities that kept them busy- and gave their parents' down time!; summer break weekly emails with links for Parsha related coloring, sheets, activities, and questions, that the parents could implement at home on Shabbos; Rosh Hashanah themed packages delivered to the door of any youth members; a Rosh Hashana children's Shofar blowing, where the children played a game of holiday bingo, heard a story from Rabbi Yolcut, and received pre-packaged snacks; Sukkos themed craft kits available for pick up; Sukkos Chol Hamoed programs, including a family trip to Wagon Trails Animal Park; Simchas Torah Children's Hakafah, where the children gathered to sing with Rabbi Yolcut and received special Simchas Torah treats; Chanukah activities including a Zoom family paint night, and opportunities to send videos and cards to the elderly at the JAA; a PZ Youth sponsored daily circle time during the week of winter break.

PZ Youth has recently implemented a weekly Zoom "Mommy and Me" on Sunday mornings for kids ages 2-6. This is ongoing, and we plan to continue as long as there is a need and parent demand.

For the coming year, we daven that, please G-d, we will soon be able to return to Shul and resume our weekly youth groups. In the interim, we will continue to provide socially distant and safe programming around each holiday. We are also considering starting a monthly Sunday "Zoom" program styled around a sponsored breakfast and parent/child learning. We are always receptive to new ideas, so please feel free to reach out.

I had the opportunity to listen to a Torah lecture that was being delivered by my Uncle, Harav Dovid Goldwasser Shlita, on the topic of Tzedakah. The word Tzedakah is based on the Hebrew word Tzedek, meaning "righteousness." Rabbi Goldwasser remarked that while we commonly translate the word Tzedakah to mean charity in the form of a monetary contribution, our sages of blessed memory teach us that there are other forms of charity that fulfill the dictum we are enjoined to observe. Giving of one's time and energy are just a few of the examples. Keeping a shul running requires many volunteers who live and breathe this.

When the Jewish nation was instructed to build the tabernacle in the wilderness, many specialized craftsman and artisans were needed. The question asked by our commentators is how did a nation that had just endured decades of slavery in Egypt possess any of these required skills? Yet, somehow the tabernacle was built exactly as instructed.

The answer is that people are born with natural abilities and when we show Hashem our desire to utilize those abilities, Hashem helps us accomplish the task. The takeaway from this that we can apply to our beautiful shul is that there are a myriad of opportunities and we just have to apply ourselves and Hashem will help with the rest!

The Sisterhood and Men's club have multiple opportunities in which one can volunteer, be it baking for the weekly Kiddush, helping stuff envelopes for various mailings, assisting with the yearly Lulav and Esrog sale and maintaining our Shul cemetery to name a few.

Attending minyan can be challenging at times, especially now, but think of the tremendous reward one receives if a mourner comes to say Kaddish and **your presence** that particular morning completes the quorum necessary to say that holy prayer.
